



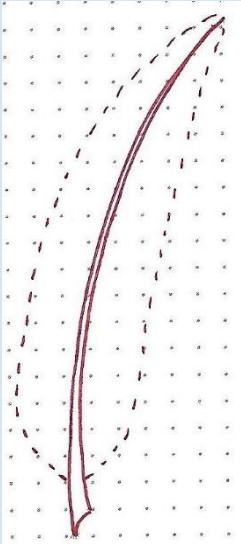
Directions

Starting with Pencil, Draw the RED Ink in Each Step. Then Ink All Lines. Erase Pencil. Color.

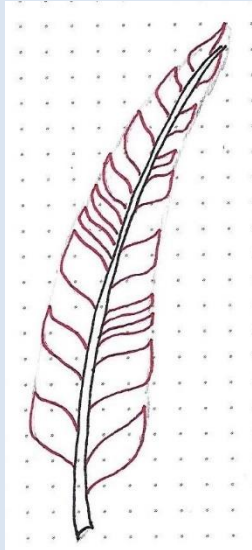
#1. In pencil draw a long graceful curve.

#2. Add second line that tapers to a point at the top. Slant bottom.

#3. Sketch a dashed shaping guide.



#4. Add offset shaped blocks to both sides of shaft, stopping at the shaping guide. Make them varied sizes and leave varied spaces between them.



#5. Fill spaces with pointed, curled, skinny barbs. These should extend outside the shaping guide.

#6. Add three curls to each side at bottom of shaft.



#7. Pencil in fills to the initial blocks using a variety of lines, curves, dots and scallops.



#8. Ink all except the initial shaping guide.

#9. Erase all pencil.



#10. Color all curled barbs the same. Use a different color for the spine. Use a variety of colors for the fills.
