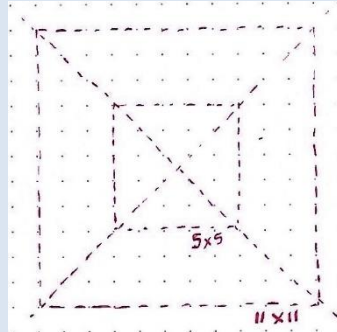


## #D19-1 "Life Preserver"

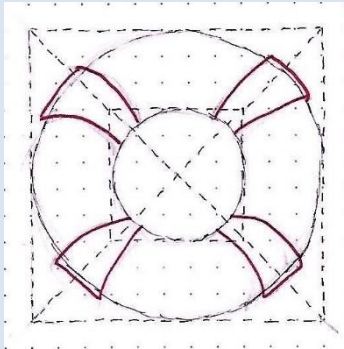
**DIRECTIONS:** P-I-E (Pencil, Ink, Erase) First use PENCIL, Draw the Red ink in each step. Then INK all lines, ERASE Pencil. COLOR

#1. In pencil, lightly make guidelines to draw a nested set of boxes. The outer box is 11 units square and the inner box is 5 units square.

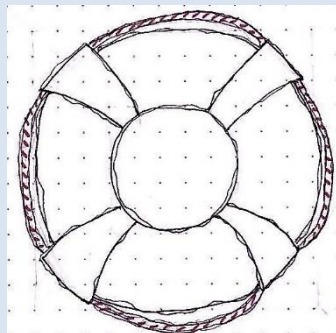


#2. Make light pencil guidelines that intersect diagonally through both boxes.

#4. At each diagonal intersection draw a curved wedge with the wider part on the outer edge, and extending slightly beyond the drawn circle. Notice how all of the wedge lines have their curves toward the top of the drawing.



#6. Make diagonal hash marks along the segments of 'rope', making sure to keep them angled in the same direction throughout.



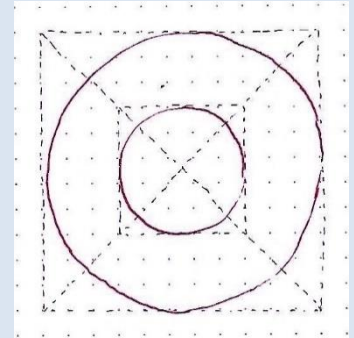
#7. Ink the wedges first, then the circles and, finally, the rope and its angled lines. NOTE that all lines (except for the hashmarks) are double lines drawn in a loose, wiggly manner. You can get away with 'flaws' in your drawing this way and any wonkiness in your lines will look planned.

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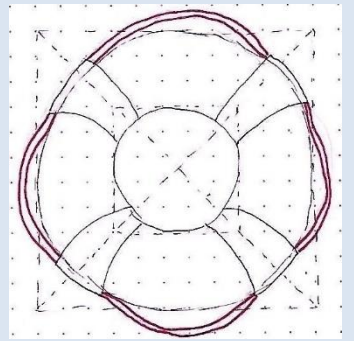

#3. Use the boxes as guides to draw nested circles.



#5. Between each of the wedges, draw a double line that flares away from the drawn circle.



#8. Erase pencil.

#9. Color the wedges red and the rope brown. To make the white ring, use light grays. Using darker shades near the bottom of each shape will impart the illusion of roundness.
