



# CBJ DRAWING LESSONS

## #D19-20 "Poppies"

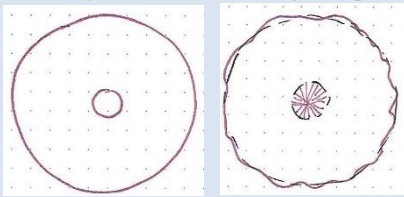
**DIRECTIONS:** P-I-E (Pencil, Ink, Erase) First use PENCIL, Draw the Red ink in each step. Then INK all lines, ERASE Pencil. COLOR

### TOP VIEW:

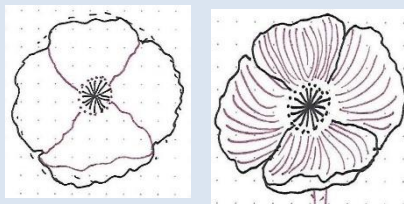
#1. Lightly pencil a circle to define the finished size of the flower. Add a small circle at the center.

#2. Change outer circle to a rippled edge. Fill small circle with radiating lines.

#3. Make 4 petals that incorporate the wavy edge then dip in to meet the center unit. Add dots around the center lines. Add curl to front edge.



#4. Draw fine lines that follow the curve of the petals. Add stem with fine hairs.

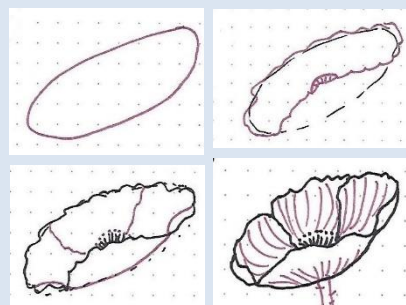


### THREE-QUARTER VIEW:

#1. Lightly pencil an oval to define the finished size of the flower.

#2. Change upper and side edge to a rippled edge and finish by raising a hill in the center bottom. Add a small half-circle with radiating lines.

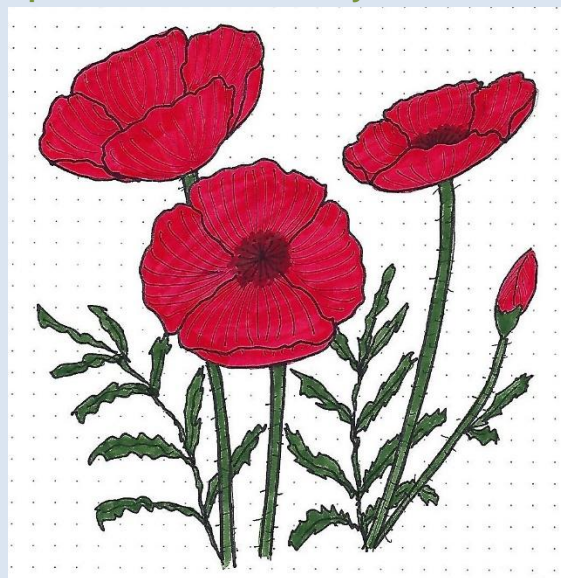
#3. Make 3 petals across the back that incorporate the wavy edge. Add dots around the center lines. Add curl to front edge on two sides.



#4. Draw fine lines that follow the curve of the petals. Add stem with fine hairs.

### FINISHING:

#5. Group flowers with the side views at top. Continue the hairy stems down to ground level. Add optional bud and scribbly leaves.



### SIDE VIEW:

#1. Lightly pencil a triangle to define the finished size of the flower, its top edge will be curved.

#2. Change upper edge to a rippled edge and continue the wavy line to form an oval at the top.

#3. Make 3 petals across the back that incorporate the wavy edge. Make front wavy edge into a front petal. Add curl to front edge on two side petals.



#4. Draw fine lines that follow the curve of the petals. Add stem with fine hairs.
