

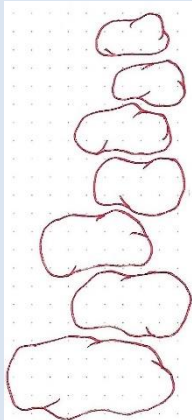


CBJ DRAWING LESSONS

#D19-4 "Stony Path"

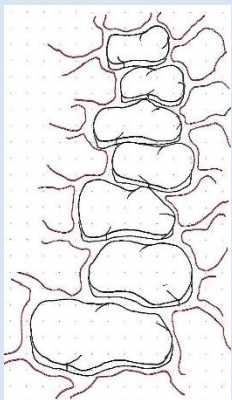
DIRECTIONS: P-I-E (Pencil, Ink, Erase) First use PENCIL, Draw the Red ink in each step. Then INK all lines, ERASE Pencil. COLOR

#1. Draw a line of cloud-shaped ovals, graduating in size from large at the bottom to smaller at the top. Their sides curve around one another but do not touch.



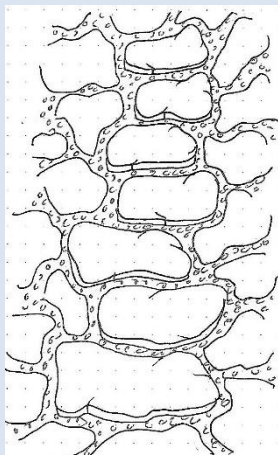
#2. Add short curved lines protruding inward at 2-3 places where the curve changes.

#5. All around the sides, add more stones that curve around but do not touch the originals or one another. DO NOT add facing edges or extensions to these.



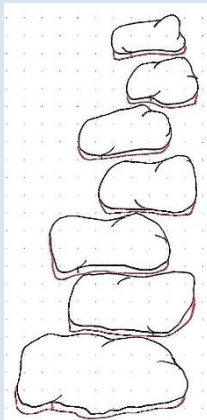
#7. Ink all lines.

#8. Erase pencil.

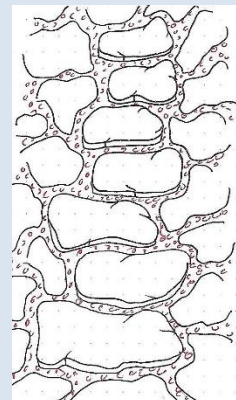


#3. From the sides, draw a short line toward you and extend it across the front edge.

#4. Add short lines to the front edge where the extensions connect.



#6. All between the stones, add tiny circles and half-circles to represent pebbles and sand.



#9. Color the center pathway in warm and cool grays in the medium range of tones. Use the same color for the front of each stone but with a darker shade.

#10. Use lighter 'natural' colors for the surrounding stones and a light sand color for the pebble area.
