

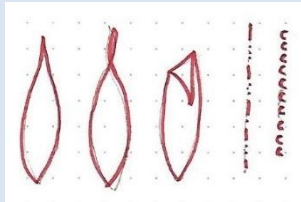


CBJ DRAWING LESSONS

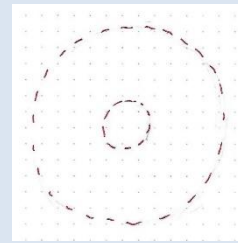
#D19-6 "Sunflower"

DIRECTIONS: P-I-E (Pencil, Ink, Erase) First use PENCIL, Draw the Red ink in each step. Then INK all lines, ERASE Pencil. COLOR

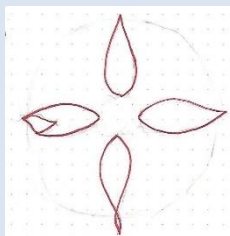
#1. In pencil, practice making these marks. You will use them in the sunflower. Number them 1 - 5 in order from left to right.



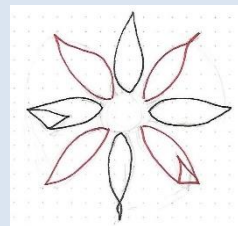
#2. Lightly draw nested guide circles. The outer one is 12 units and the inner one is 2 1/2 units.



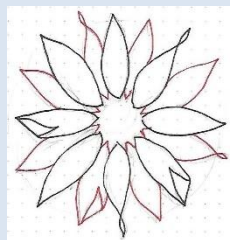
#3. At the top, bottom and sides draw in petals that just touch the inner circle and just cross the outer one. Make the top and right petals like sample 1. The bottom is petal 2 and the left is petal 3.



#4. Centered between each of the petals, draw another petal. You will use two more petal 1 on the left side, petal 2 in the upper right and 3 in the lower right.

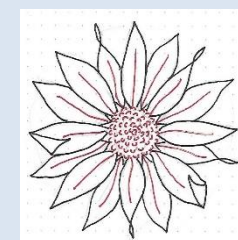


#5. Centered between every one of the drawn petals, add one more behind. Use a mix of 1, 2, and 3 petals.



#6. Add a single line inside of each petal from the center out to 3/4 the length.

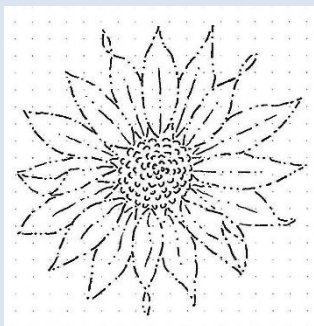
#7. Use the marks labeled 5 from step one to fill in the center in concentric circles or a gradual spiral.



#8. Use pen to outline all the petals and their center lines using the dots and dashes lines labeled as 4 in step one.

#9. If you wish to add leaves, use the dots and dashes lines for both their outlines and veins. They will be fat and tucked behind the bloom.

#10. Erase pencil.



#10. Color the sunflower dark yellow and the center brown.

#11. If you have added leaves, color them dull green.
