
Font: "New"

Activity 1: Introduction

We are starting our New Year with a fun font using the word NEW. In this font, think triangles and circles. The letters are formed with long triangles and then embellished with small circles. The circles can be placed inside the letter or along any side of the letter. This allows for individual creativity!

Draw the word NEW several times in pencil then trace in your choice of ink. Don't forget to erase your pencil lines once the ink is dry.

You may choose to fill in the triangles that form your letters or you may leave them hollow. You have the same option for your circle embellishments. I had fun varying the colors and I hope you will enjoy this font!






Font: "New" Activity 2: Alphabet

Here is the full alphabet for the font NEW. Remember long triangles and little circles. You will also notice that where lines meet, they often extend beyond the intersection. You can choose to do this where I've done it or not extend the lines at all. I think it's fun to see everyone's individuality here!

I used a Prismacolor pen to outline my letters and colored them in with color markers. Have fun!

When drawing your words for this font, remember long triangles, circles and overlapping intersections! Relax and have fun! Also, remember P-I-E. Pencil, ink, erase!




Font: "New" Activity 4: ScriptureWriting

On Thursdays we practice our font by writing a scripture passage on paper before using it in our Bibles on Friday.
