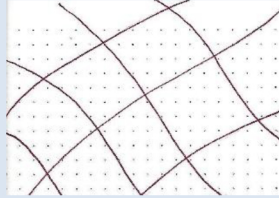


Fishing Net

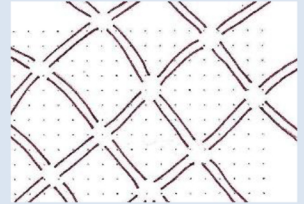
Drawing Lesson

Suggested Verses for this drawing: Mark 1:16-18, Luke 5:4, John 21:11

#1. In pencil, sketch a curved grid over the surface where the net will be.

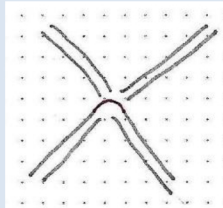


#2. At every intersection, create an unconnected grid of double lines. These are the strings of the net.

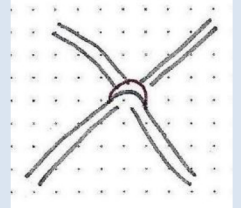


NOTE: Complete the following steps on ALL the intersections at the same time.

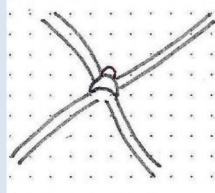
#3. Draw an arched line to connect the outside ends of the two lower strings.



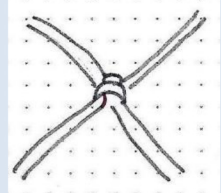
#4. Add a line arching over the last one that is about the same thickness as the strings.



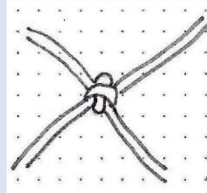
#5. Add a back loop between the two upper strings.



#6. Make a downward curved line under the step 3 arch and connect it to the lower left string.



#7. Complete the new string by curving a new line down and under the last one drawn.



#8. Ink all lines. Erase pencil.

#9. Color strings using a darker tone where the strings pass under one another.
