

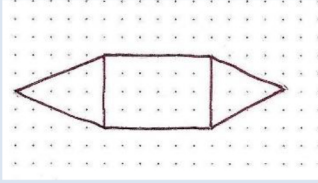
Drawing Lesson

“Fish”

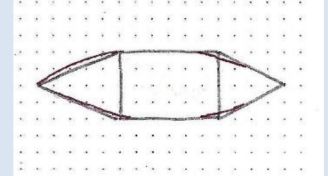
Suggested Verses for this drawing:

Matthew 4:18-19, Matt 7:10, Matt 13:47-48, Mark 1:16-17, Mark 8:7, Luke 5:4-10, Luke 24:42, John 21:3

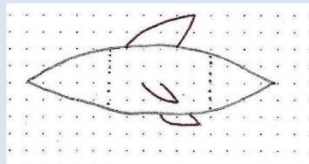
#1. In pencil lightly make a guide box that measures 6 units wide by 4 units high. Add a triangle to left end extending 5 units. Add a triangle to the opposite end that extends 4 units.



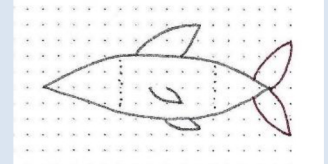
#2. On the long end bulge the sides of the triangle slightly. On the short end trim the intersections inward to create a gentle curve.



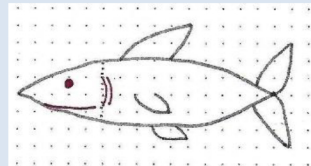
#3. Create wedge-shaped fins on top, center and bottom of fish. Note relative sizes.



#4. At the shorter point create two leaf-shaped tail fins. Note size and placement.

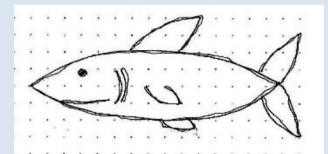


#5. Add eye, mouth and gills on the left end.



#6. Trace all features with doubled lines of ink.

#7. Erase pencil.



NOTES:

- These are not a 'real' species of fish so they can be any colors you choose.
- If you want to layer fish on top of one another, do so after step 5 (before inking).
- Stacked fish can be headed all in the same direction to indicate a 'school' or scrambled up if they have been 'caught'.
- You have the option of making these a shorter or a fatter fish by changing the original rectangle size in step 1.
