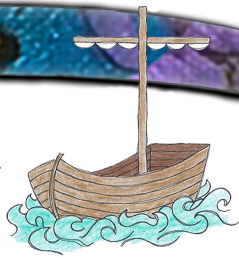


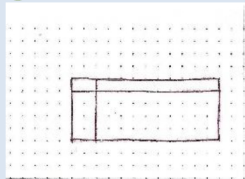
# “Boat”



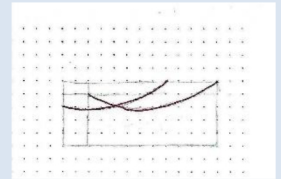
# Drawing Lesson

Suggested Verses for this drawing: Mark 3:9, Mark 4:1, Mark 4:36-38, Mark 6:32-34, Mark 8:10-14, Luke 5:2-7, Luke 8:22-23, John 6:17-24, John 21:3-8, Matthew 4:21-22, Matthew 13:2

**#1. In pencil, lightly draw a guide box 12 units wide with a vertical line separating the two left units. Make it 5 units high with a horizontal line separating the top unit.**

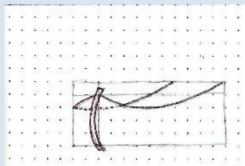


**#2. Use the guidelines on the box to create the two sagging lines indicated.**



**#3. At the vertical division, draw a double-lined curve to just past the bottom of the rectangle.**

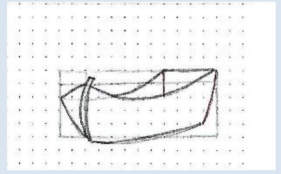
**#4. Connect the bow beam to the left side of the rectangle with a curved line.**



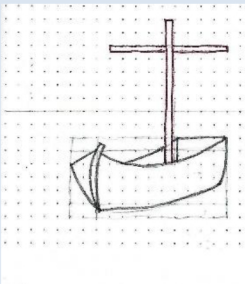
**#5. Connect the right sides of the two lines from step 2.**

**#6. Connect the inner corner of the stern with the near side of the boat with a vertical line.**

**#7. Create the back of the boat on the right with a curved line. Draw the bottom of the boat with a gently curved line.**

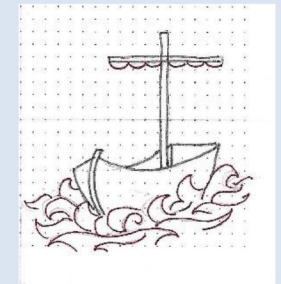


**#8. Refer to picture for placement of a mast.**

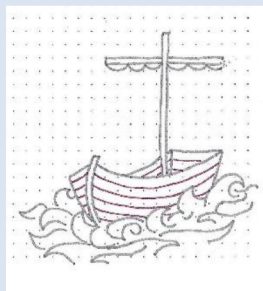


**#9. Add folded sail to mast crossbeam.**

**#10. Add waves, gentle water or sand (depending on how you want your boat staged)**



**#11. Add boards to the hull of the boat. Don't forget the inside. All sections are drawn in equidistant lines beginning at the top edge.**



**#12. Ink all with doubled lines. Erase pencil. Color as desired.**
