



DIRECTIONS: Starting with Pencil, draw the RED ink in each step. Then ink all lines. Erase Pencil. Color

#D-232 Sweet Osmanthus



#1. Pencil a guide circle to define the size of your flower head.



#2. Pencil 'X' and '+' scattered along circle and within it.



#3. Draw a line outside the shapes and finish with a center dot.



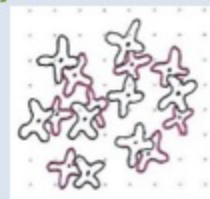
#4. Do all the florets this way.



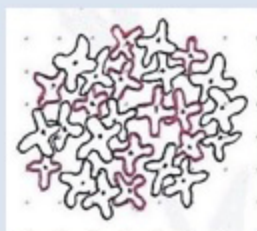
#5. Add more 'X' and '+' overlapping the original florets.



#6. Turn these into florets also, making them go behind the first layer.



#7. Continue adding layers until flower head is full.



#8. Add stem.

#9. Add offset thin leaves to stem and add a couple on top.



#10. Color green leaves, stem and inside flower head. Sweet Osmanthus (a fragrant Asian bush) is most commonly cream, yellow or orange although it does sometimes show up in pink, light purple or red.
