2	3	NOTES: In the Bible, the word forbearance usually refers God abstaining or holding back His righteous judgement of sin. God demonstrates forbearance through His mercy, kindness, and longsuffering toward His children. Since God is patient, He desires those who seek Him to be patient as well. In this sense, we should demonstrate patience and self-control. The verses for this month explore all these attributes of God, plus how we should respond to His example. Take the verse of the day in first-person and pray it back to God. These are just examples – feel free to change them up and make them uniquely yours.
