



CBJ DRAWING LESSONS


#D19-12 "Peacock"

DIRECTIONS: P-I-E (Pencil, Ink, Erase) First use PENCIL, Draw the Red ink in each step. Then INK all lines, ERASE Pencil. COLOR

#1. In pencil, on scratch paper, practice making these forms by drawing each series of red lines.



#2. On your drawing paper, use pencil to draw a guide oval at a 45-degree angle.



#3. Draw a smaller oval at the upper left of the guide.




#4. Connect the center right of the small oval to the center bottom left of the larger oval using a line that curves similar to a question mark.




#5. Just touching the bottom of the curved line you just made, draw a guide circle, aligning the right side with the right side of the first oval.




#6. Intersecting with the circle at about 1/3 of its diameter, draw a guide oval that leans heavily to the left. It will be about twice the size of the circle.




#7. On top of the upper oval, draw a guide of a half circle centered over the head.



#8. Add a single line beak to the left of the head and two vertical legs at the bottom.




#9. Inside the half-circle, draw radiating lines and end each with a single dot. Add claws to feet.



#10. Starting at the back of the head, follow the top guide oval until it connects with the circle then follow that to the lower oval. From the question mark, connect to the front of the circle and on down to the lower oval. Make all transitions smooth.

#11. Draw a pencil guide for a tail that has soft curves along its perimeter and sweeps to the left. It will expand as it comes toward the bottom and end in a soft point.



#13. In pencil, use the marks from step #1 to decorate the bird. A leaf shape will stand in for the wing. Fill the tail area with Various sizes of 5-petal flowers then fill between with leaves and spiral flowers. Finish by filling open areas with clusters of three dots.



#14. Ink, erase pencil and color in teal, green and blue.
