
#D19-21 "Wreath"

DIRECTIONS: P-I-E (Pencil, Ink, Erase) First use PENCIL, Draw the Red ink in each step. Then INK all lines, ERASE Pencil. COLOR

#1. Practice drawing these various flowers, leaves and sprigs. 1




#2. Using pencil, lightly draw a circle of 5 lines, crossing them as you desire to look twined.



#3. Draw in 5 of the pods (#1) with the points facing up on the upper half of the circle and left on the lower

#4. Add 4-5 of the daisy bloom (#3), spaced around the right side.



#5. Use 3 tulips (#2) and 2 buds (#8) facing up and left.



#6. Space 3 side blooms (#7) around the and right



#8. Add 5 leaf clusters (#5) tucked into spaces between flowers. They should face up and left on the top half or left on the bottom half.



#9. Add 3 EACH of the sprigs (#4 and #6) to fill in spaces.



#10. Fill any leftover empty areas with ruffled leaves (#10).

#11. Trace all the floral elements in ink.

#12. Trace the original vines, skipping where they go behind the florals.



#13. Erase pencil.

#14. Color the flowers in various colors, being consistent with each species. Use various greens for different leaves. Trace vines in brown.



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
