

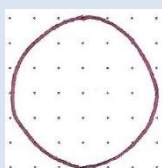


CBJ DRAWING LESSONS

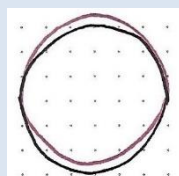
#D19-33 "Magnifying Glass"

DIRECTIONS: P-I-E (Pencil, Ink, Erase) First use **PENCIL**, Draw the **Red ink** in each step. Then **INK** all lines, **ERASE** Pencil. **COLOR**

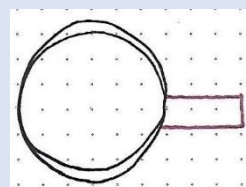
#1. In pencil, draw a circle that is 6 units across.



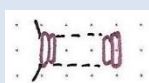
#2. Make a second circle of the same size that sits $\frac{1}{2}$ unit higher.



#3. Add a rectangle to the right side of the circles. It will be one unit high and three units long.



#4. Draw a large and a small flattened oval on each end of the side rectangle (only the rectangle unit is illustrated in the next few steps, to save space).



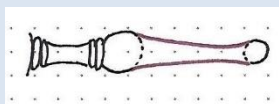
#5. On each long side of the rectangle connect the inner flattened ovals with concave lines.



#6. On the right end of the rectangle unit add a circle that is just short of two units (about $1\frac{3}{4}$). Skip over 4 units to the right and add another circle that is one unit across.

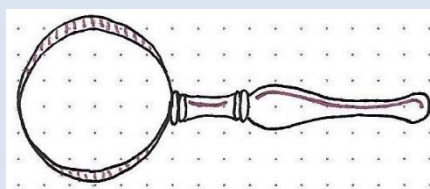


#7. Connect the large and small circles with long concave lines.



#8. Trace in ink and erase pencil.

#9. Make hashmarks inside the overlap of the lens circles. Then add reflection lines that echo the length of the handle.



#10. Add a couple of curved reflection lines inside the lens.

#11. The magnifying glass lens rim should be colored with silver or gold. The handle can match the lens rim or might be colored with browns to mimic wood.
