

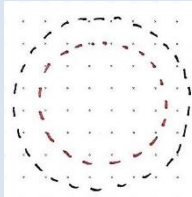


# CBJ DRAWING LESSONS

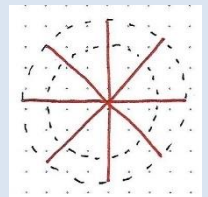
## #D19-38 "Dandelion"

**DIRECTIONS:** P-I-E (Pencil, Ink, Erase) First use **PENCIL**, Draw the **Red ink** in each step. Then **INK** all lines, **ERASE** Pencil. **COLOR**

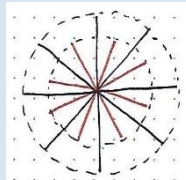
**#1.** In pencil, lightly make nested circles. The outer ring is 8 units square and the inner is 5.5 units.



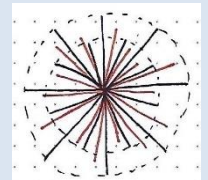
**#2.** On each + and x axis draw lines that reach to the outer ring and cross at the center.



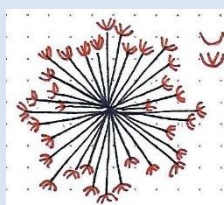
**#3.** At every interval between the + and x lines add a line that reaches to the inner ring and crosses at the center.



**#4.** Between each line add another one sometimes reaching between the rings and sometimes coming short of the inner ring. You want to have a full burst of varying lengths.



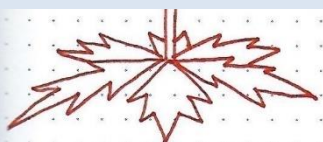
**#5.** Note the little style guide on the right. First there is drawn a wide 'U' shape and then a narrower 'V' shape inside it. You will add one of these figures to the end of every line in your burst. If you don't think your burst looks 'full' enough, add a few little UV figures lower down toward the center to fill in.



**#9.** Color the leaves and stems green. Use a very light color to create a hazy ball over the entire seed head.



**#6.** At the base ('ground level') draw 5 spiky leaves with a double-lined stem extending up to the center of the dandelion.



**#7.** Add a center vein to each of the leaves.

**#8.** Ink everything except the initial guide circles. Erase pencil.
