



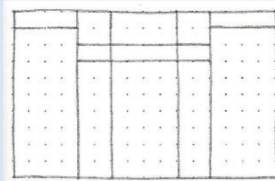
CBJ DRAWING LESSONS

#D19-42 "Fortress"

DIRECTIONS: P-I-E (Pencil, Ink, Erase) First use PENCIL, Draw the Red ink in each step. Then INK all lines, ERASE Pencil. COLOR

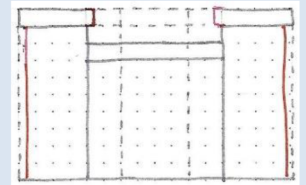
#1. In pencil, lightly make a guide box that is 16 unit wide and 10 units high.

#2. Add vertical lines 4 units and 6 units from each side. Add horizontal lines 1 unit from the top of the outer rectangles and 2 and 3 units from the top spanning the 3 center sections.



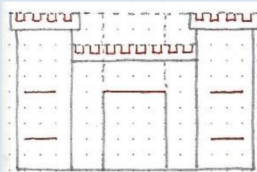
#3. Extend the top outer rectangles inward by 1/2 unit.

#4. Indent the two outer long sides 1/2 unit inward.



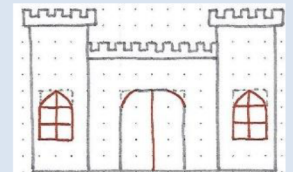
#5. Turn tops of the towers and front wall into battlements with indents that are 1/2 unit wide and tall.

#6. Make horizontal lines in the three sections as shown, matching widths and vertical placement.



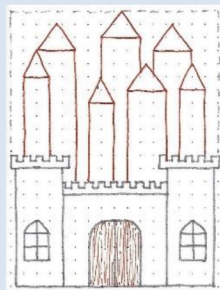
#7. Peak the tops of the two windows and add gridwork.

#8. Round the upper corners of the door and add a vertical center line.

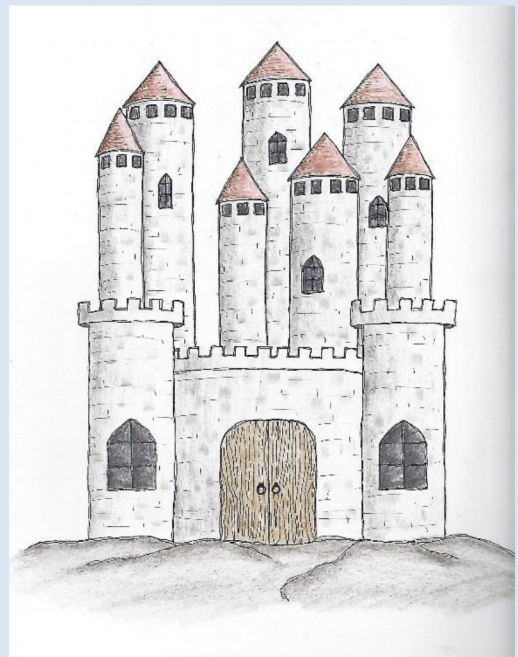


#9. Add woodgrain to front doors.

#10. Add multiple towers with peaked roofs to an area up to 11 units above the battlements.



#12. Ink drawing (adding door rings and rocky foreground if desired), erase pencil, color.



#11. Turn the horizontals of the tower roofs, the battlements and their caps into slightly curved lines (to show height). Add small windows to tops of towers (and mid-tower if you wish). Add light horizontal lines and tiny random vertical tic-marks all over the walls (indicates stonework). Add horizontal lines to the left side of the rooftops (to indicate tile).
