


#D19-47 "Cityscape"

DIRECTIONS: P-I-E (Pencil, Ink, Erase) First use PENCIL, Draw the Red ink in each step. Then INK all lines, ERASE Pencil. COLOR


#1. In pencil, lightly make 4 rectangles across the bottom of a section measuring 14 units tall and 20 units wide.



#2. Add a second row of 4 rectangles behind the first.
These will be 1 to 2 units taller and overlap by 1 to 2 units.




#3. Add a third row of blocks, again making them taller and overlapping. On this row do not place rectangles off to the outsides of the first two rows.




#4. Add another row with buildings closer together.




#5. This is your last row – just a couple of buildings toward the center.



#6. On every upper-right corner, add an angled line that measures ½ unit wide, making them all at the same angle.



#7, To every angled line add a vertical line that connects it to the ground or the building in front of it.

#8. On random buildings make edits to the rooflines – try peaked roofs, stacked roofs or a tower or antenna.

#9. Ink roofs then buildings starting with the front row and moving backward. Erase pencil.
