

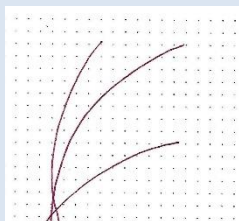


CBJ DRAWING LESSONS

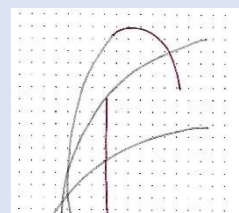
#D19-48 "Wheat"

DIRECTIONS: P-I-E (Pencil, Ink, Erase) First use PENCIL, Draw the Red ink in each step. Then INK all lines, ERASE Pencil. COLOR

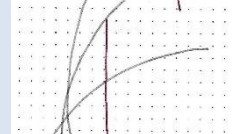
#1. In pencil, lightly make three stalks that are arcs of circles, beginning together at the bottom left third and arcing to the right.



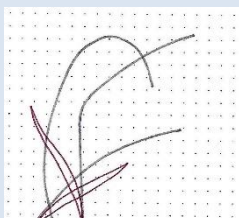
#2. Make an edit to the upper left so that it droops downward in a smooth arc.



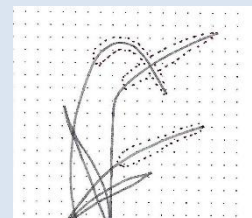
#3. Make an edit to the middle one so its midpoint drops straight down.



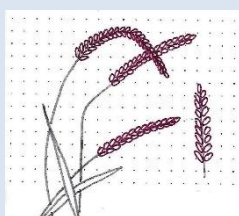
#4. From the bottom of two stems add long tapering leaves.



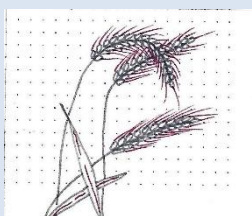
#5. On the tops of each stem pencil in an area to define the size of the seed head.



#6. Refer to the inset for design of head. Seed kernels are oval and sit at an angle to the stem. Kernels sit directly across from one another.

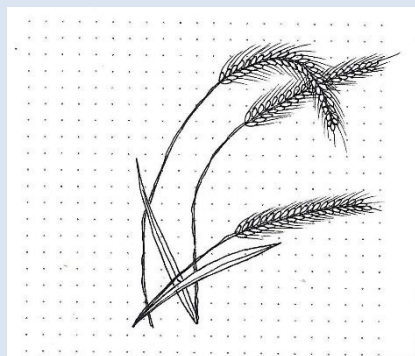


#7. From the end of every kernel draw a line away from the stem.



#8. Ink the entire drawing and erase the pencil.

#9. Add second line to all outlines using ink.



#10. Add color, using a lighter tone over the beard (spikes)
