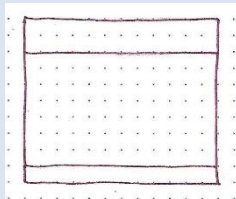


#D19-52 "Well"

DIRECTIONS: P-I-E (Pencil, Ink, Erase) First use PENCIL, Draw the Red ink in each step. Then INK all lines, ERASE Pencil. COLOR

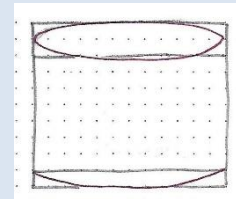
#1. In pencil, lightly make a guide box that measures 12 unit wide and 10 units high.

#2. Divide with horizontal lines 2 units from the top edge and 1 unit from the bottom edge.



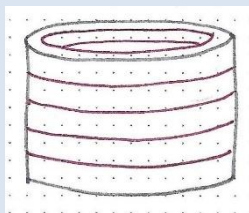
#3. Use the upper divided area as a guide to create an oval. You can dip *very slightly* below the inner line.

#4. Use the bottom divided area as a guide to create an arc. This should mimic the lower curve of the upper oval.

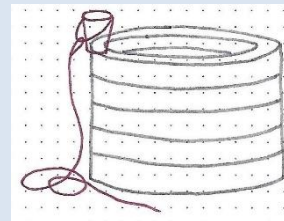


#5. Draw a smaller oval inside the upper one.

#6. Draw 4 evenly spaced curved lines that echo the lines already in place. Add one curved line *inside* the well.

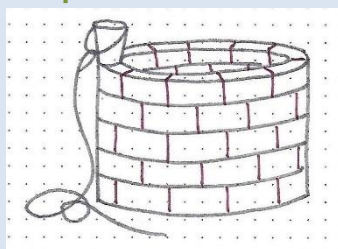


#7. To the upper left rim of the well, sketch in a bucket with a rope hanging to the ground.



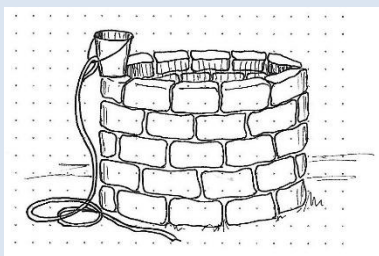
#7. Divide the rings on the face of the well into offset bricks. Note how the lines on the upper rim take off at an angle from the top row of bricks.

#8. Complete bricks inside well and on back rim.



#9. Use ink to outline all the bricks, leaving spacing between them (for the grout). Erase pencil.

#10. Add shading lines to extreme sides of bucket and well. Shade interior of well.



#11. Color using multiple shades of gray with darkest in grout lines, mid-tone on the lower left of brick corners and well interior, and lightest on remainder of brick faces. Colors of remainder of setting are personal choice.
