

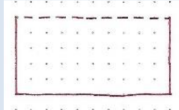


# CBJ DRAWING LESSONS

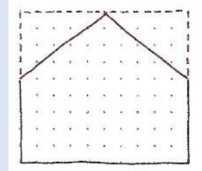
## #D19-25 "Country Church"

**DIRECTIONS:** P-I-E (Pencil, Ink, Erase) First use **PENCIL**, Draw the **Red ink** in each step. Then **INK** all lines, **ERASE** Pencil. **COLOR**

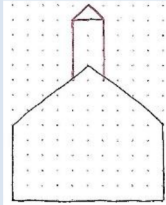
**#1.** In pencil, lightly make guidelines to draw a rectangle 10 units wide by 5 units tall. The dashed line is for reference and will not be drawn.



**#2.** On top of your rectangle add a triangle top that is centered and 4 units tall.

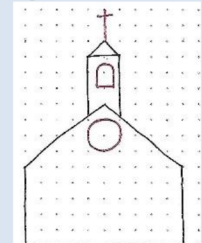


**#3.** Draw a tower extending 3 units above the peak and 2 units wide. Bring the lower sides down to meet the roof line.

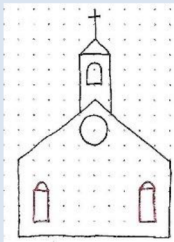


**#4.** Add a triangle roof to the steeple that is 2 units wide and 1 unit tall.

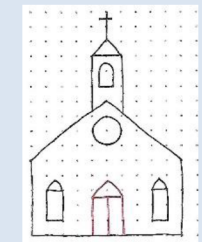
**#5.** Three units are added in this step: a cross that is 1 unit wide and 2 units tall; a domed opening in the steeple that is 1 unit wide and 1.5 units tall; and a round window in the roof peak that is 2 units across.



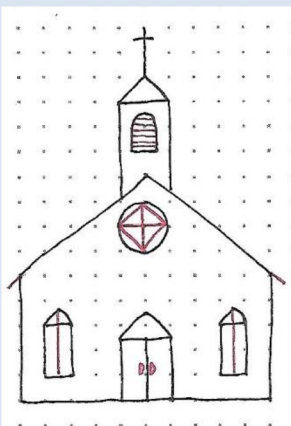
**#6.** At the lower sides of the building, add two window rectangles that are 1 unit wide and 2 units high. Add peaked domes to their tops – about 1/2 unit high.



**#7.** In the center bottom, draw double doors that are 3 units high and 1 unit wide each. Add a peaked dome over the top of the two together that is 1 unit high.



**#8.** Add details: slats in the steeple opening; divisions in the round window; vertical divisions in the lower side windows; and small knobs on the double doors.



**#9.** Ink the drawing using light sketchy lines. Erase pencil.

**#10.** Color as desired. Landscape details can be added and colored as well.
